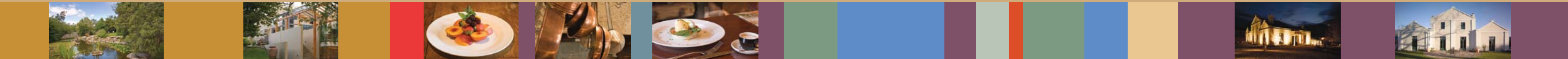

Originally built in 1847, Islington is a fine example of Regency architecture, sympathetically restored to showcase its original glory and updated to include the little luxuries our forebears overlooked such as en-suite bathrooms, a glass roofed pavilion for gazing at the mountains and the moon, and a fine wine cellar.

Within the hotel are large and spacious bedrooms offering king or twin bed options, decorated with sumptuous fabrics, original artworks and objects, and deeply restful Tasmanian custom made Islington Angel beds that once settled in, you will never wish to leave.

Adjoining are large, crisp white marble en-suite bathrooms, with marble and timber shoji screen walls that glow like oversized jewel boxes, housing deep baths, separate overhead shower stalls and toilet, and embraced by a warmed, ruby granite floor.
